<b>Situation of the country or area</b>	In the last 20 years, Mozambique has experienced an uninterrupted period of great economic growth, favored by the result macroeconomic stability, from the process of deregulation and privatization and from the implementation of market reforms that have

	<p>allowed the country to create a stable environment for the attraction of direct investments. Some studies conducted in recent years show that some surveys on household budgets have shown the persistence of poverty in rural areas and the worsening of social inequalities. In the areas of great penetration of capital, social expectations are high, which - when they are not satisfied - gives rise to feelings of exclusion. In this scenario, social tensions increase and new conflicts emerge, formally expressed (through the organized movements of civil society) and informally with various modes of expression. The issue around which the major concerns of the government and the entire population revolve is that of "lack of jobs".</p>
