















BANUU - WP4 online trainings January-April 2021

RATIONALE OF THE TRAINING

GENERAL OBJECTIVES:

The WP4 aimed at providing Iraqi teaching staff with updated skills on how to disseminate vision and competencies among students for building a society-business entreprise involved in cultural heritage, and at planning new pathways to develop employability and entrepreneurship opportunities for Iraqi students after graduation starting from their Humanities knowledge. Indeed, the creation of innovative entrepreneurial ideas and opportunities for young researchers can lead Iraq towards a stronger, more sustainable and competitive economy and support the enhamencement and the development of the Iraqi cultural heritage. On the bases of these targets, the WP4 focused on the planning and designing of activities improving students' transversal skills in order to foster their entrepreneurial capacities.

At the beginning of the WP4 schedule, due to the current gap in the Iraqi teaching competencies on procedures and features of the private sector, a selected Iraqi university teaching staff attended a seminar on how to foster and increase students' transversal skills and to enhance new working opportunies in the cultural field. By the acquisition of this updated entrepreneurial knowledge, the Iraqi academic staff members were able to support the selected students in the elaboration of entreprenerial ideas which can be not only theoretical experiments but feasible job opportunities. Ideed, after a set of trainings, the Iraqi students were involved in practical entrepreneurship activities in order to develop new start-up projects in the field of Humanities. The trainings were conducted by the CRAST (Centro Ricerche Archeologiche e Scavi di Torino per il Medio Oriente e l'Asia) team with the participation of external experts who trained and supported the selected academic staff members and the students to develop their entreprenerial ideas. These activities aimed also at the increase of the teachers-students interactions in order to intensify the professional partnership inside and outside universities.

The schedule and the subject matter of the WP4 trainings were coordinated by the CRAST team in cooperation with the project partners (Alma Mater Studiorum Università di Bologna, Koç University, University of Baghdad, University of Kufa, University of Mosul and University of al-Qadisiyah) and the State Board of Antiquities and Heritage (SBAH, BANUU associated partner).

STRUCTURE AND METHODOLOGY:

Differently from the initial scheduling, due to the pandemic emergency, the trainings (5 lessons and 5 workshops) were held online, by using the Google Meet platform (except for the meeting 5 which was organized on Zoom). All the meetings were scheduled in the afternoon (3:00 pm Iraqi time), as Iraqi university courses and academic activities usually occur mainly in the morning; therefore, this time schedule allowed an easier participation of the trainees (university professors and students). Participants:

- ➤ 44 Iraqi academic staff members (Universities of Baghdad, Kufa, Mosul, al-Qadisiyah, 11 for each university);
- > 52 university students (Universities of Baghdad, Kufa, Mosul, al-Qadisiyah, 13 for each university);
- ➤ BANUU partners and contact persons (Universities of Baghdad, Kufa, Mosul, al-Qadisiyah).

The selection of the participants was carried out by the scientific and administrative committees of the Iraqi partner universities. Professors and students, who were involved in the project, are archaeologists (Colleges



















of Archaeology), art historians (Colleges of Art), scholars and researchers in Economics and Administration (Colleges of Administration and Economics and Colleges of Business Management), scholars and researchers in Education (Colleges of Education for Humanities, Colleges of Basic Education and Colleges for Humanity Sciences) and engineers (Faculties of Engineering). The prerequisites for the participation, in addition to the specific professional and academic background and the interest in the cultural heritage enhancement through innovative professional pathways, were the full availability toward all the steps of the WP4 project, the utmost attention to the CRAST staff's communications by e-mail and the ease of availability.

The initial 5 meetings were realized like traditional lessons with two breaks for the discussion among participants and questions in the middle and at the end of the lecture. During these lessons, the trainers showed ppt presentations which were shared with all the participants after the meeting.

The following 5 meetings were organized in the shape of workshops/ateliers to support the gradual elaboration of entrepreneurial projects by the trainees, who were divided into 12 different work groups (3 for each university). During each meeting, after compiling specific business templates (shared by email before the lesson), the groups presented their results, improving step by step their concepts with the help of the Italian experts.

At the beginning of each meeting, the link for compiling a Google attendance form was shared with the participants in order to confirm their participation.

At the end of the teaching path, the groups presented their projects, summarized in posters which were uploaded to the BANUU website in pdf format and to the 12th ICAANE (online International Congress on the Archaeology of the Ancient Near East organized by the University of Bologna) platform by a link.

TRAINING SCHEDULE:

The WP4 online training activity was divided into three main steps:

The first training activity concerned the entrepreneurship and business planning, and was intended for academic staff members.

This activity consisted of two online lessons (25th-26th of January 2021) only addressed to the academic staff members (professors, assistant professors, lecturers, faculty administrators). During these meetings, the invited trainers (Prof. Cecchini and Prof. Paolucci) introduced to the trainees some main topics related to the startups creation (*How to design a start-up project?*) and the communication of these to the students within specific university pathways (*How to communicate the main skills to the students?*). This module aimed at providing baseline tools concerning the private entrepreneurship in order to start within the university teaching programs educational paths for the enhancement of students' business skills in the field of the cultural heritage.

Main topics:

• entrepreneurial skills and competencies



















- analysis of the offered product/service;
- customer discovery and following analysis of the market;
- definition of strategy and technological roadmap;
- definition of the marketing plan;
- preparation of the organizational plan.
- > The second training activity concerned the presentation of some examples of cultural startups creation and management (*How to design a cultural start-up project*?) and was intended for both academic staff members and students.

During these three meetings (3rd, 9th and 10th of Febraury 2021), the examples of successful Italian startups (*Ad Hoc 3D Solutions, A.R.Va. Archeologia Ricerca e Valorizzazione, Art Stories*), involved in the cultural heritage protection and documentation, in the tourism promotion and development, and in the cultural education improvement, were presented to the trainees in order to inspire the creation of innovative entrepreneurial ideas.

The third training activity concerned the elaboration of entrepreneurial projects by the 12 university groups (3 for each university; each group was composed of both academic staff members and students; the selection of the groups was carried out by the Iraqi Universities' BANUU partners).

The elaboration of new startup projects was carried out during five workshops organized and led by the CRAST team with the support of Italian professionals (Dr. Giovanna Hirsch and Dr. Federica Pascotto, *Artstories S.r.l/Associazione Culturale Bartolomeo*).

This activity supported the Iraqi teaching staff and students in the application of their acquired skills, creating pathways to design new startup projects aiming at the promotion and enhancement of Iraqi monuments, museums and archaeological sites.

TRAINING SESSIONS

LESSON 1 (25th January 2021, at 3 pm Iraqi time)

Title: Training on how to design a startup projects: Startup & Entrepreneurship

Trainer/s: Professor Davide Achille Cecchini (University of Turin, Department of Management)

Aim of the lesson: introduction, addressed to the academic staff members, of the main topics concerning the creation of an innovative business company or startup.

Description: the meeting, which lasted about two hours, concerned the introduction, by a ppt presentation, of the fundamental organizational and economic elements that need to characterize an entrepreneurial idea for developing and becoming a successful company. The explaination included contents such as the definition and some examples of existing international startups, the procedures of startup creation, the importance of the team work and the necessity of staff multidisciplinarity, the main startup characteristics (limited resources, importance of the customer), the main startup perils (difficulty of self-sustainability under economic terms), the necessity of in-depth analysis of competitors, the difference between inventor and entrepreneur and the entrepreneur characteristics, the correct management of startup costs, the support of the technological communication instruments. At the end of the meeting, the Canvas template were introduced to the trainees as initial tool to sketch an entrepreneurial idea.

LESSON 2 (26th January 2021, at 3 pm Iraqi time)

Title: Training on how to design a start-up projects: Entrepreneurial ventures and digital transformation: what is the lesson for cultural heritage?

Trainer/s: Professor Emilio Paolucci (Politecnico of Turin, Department of Management and Production Engineering)

Aim of the lesson: follow up meeting, which lasted about two hours, addressed to academic staff members in order to discuss the technological steps within the creation of a startup, the detailed study of the management needs, and the presentation of the main features of innovative entrepreneurial ideas concerning the cultural heritage. The presentation included contents such as the nature of a startup and the main differences in terms



















of objectives, entrepreneurs' vision, potential of growth, and field of activity; the correct journey of an entrepreneurial idea; the creation of compelling value proposition for customers, the need of funding, and the necessary amount; the types and the role of investors (mentors, industry leaders, pilots, angels, customers, channel partners and venture capitalist); the differences of digital startups focused on "cultural heritage"; the top 20 reasons of startups fail; the importance of the value proposition (result of competitors offer, market needs and technology product/functional capabilities) and the customer value proposition (result of technology push and demand pull); the more widespread types of startups (Lifestyle Startups; Small-Business Startups; Scalable Startups; Buyable Startups; Large-Company Startups; Social Startups). At the end of the meeting, the trainer presented some examples of technologies which can create opportunities for startups focused on cultural heritage (Europeana, Google Arts and Culture, Unesco, other Big data and digital platforms), and new digital solutions for the observation of artefacts and the research of cultural contents (for example the exploration of 3-dimensional space and the virtual reality). Due to the impact of COVID 19 on cultural heritage, it was highlighted how new ways of teaching and learning cultural heritage by technological startups could enhance and develop the dissemination of culture and knowledge.

LESSON 3 (3rd February 2021, at 3 pm Iraqi time)

Title: Training on how to design a start-up projects: Ad Hoc 3D Solutions: Geomatics service providers

Trainer/s: Dr. Paolo Ardissone (Ad Hoc 3d Solutions s.r.l)

Aim of the lesson: presentation of the main activities of a successful Italian entreprise involved in the development of technological methodologies for the protection, documentation, promotion and fruition of the cultural heritage.

Description: the main topic of the meeting concerned the presentation of new technological tools used by private entreprises for the protection and documentation of the cultural heritage (updated procedures of preventive archaeology).

The trainer introduced some examples of solutions for 3D survey and cartography by new technologies and different acquisition techniques (laser scanner, topography, digital photogrammetry and innovative data processing logics), by stressing the importance of methodological choices based on the context, logistics and client needs; the use of technological tools in the archaeological context. Based on the experience of *Ad Hoc 3D Solutions*, the trainer presented the softwares *Ad Hoc Archaeological Manager* (created for the acquisition and catalogue of archaeological data) and *Ad Hoc VR* (virtual reality software), some 3D models elaborations for cultural heritage dissemination and documentation (examples: Hathor Goddess statue, Hung -e Azdhar relief), and some cases of use of archaeological instruments and techniques in the engineering field (for example the Ad Hoc project in Monte Bianco tunnel).

LESSON 4 (9th February 2021, at 3 pm Iraqi time)

Title: Training on how to design a start-up projects: The Archaeological Park of Rudiae: an example of enhancement

Trainer/s: Dr. Sara Bozza and Dr. Panarelli (A.R.Va srl).

Aim of the lesson: the meeting aimed at the presentation of traditional and innovative tools for an easier and original touristic fruition of the cultural heritage, by showing a significant case study, the archaeological park of Rudiae in southern Italy.

Description: the trainer described the steps of elaboration and foundation of A.R.Va: this startup is a University spin-off (a company created in the University of Salento as part of the activities of the Department of Cultural Heritage). The associates are students, researchers, young professionals and professors (representing the University). Then, this entreprise represents an interesting example of university business activity. During the meeting, the trainers explained the University Third Mission activities, such as the cultural, social and economic development of the society by the knowledge transfer, the innovation, the social engagement and the scientific communication by the construction of new interactions between universities and local and national communities. The trainers showed how the archaeologists of the company can apply the skills acquired during their studies, generating a personal and community economic impact. The mission of this association is to provide technical and scientific support to public and private clients through innovative research and development services, based on multidisciplinary approaches (archaeological excavations and research projects; rescue archaeology/cataloguing of artefacts/GIS/CAD projects/surveys with drone; laser scanner and photogrammetry; guided tours/multimedia products/virtual reconstructions/cultural events/experimental archaeology; workshops, didactic activities for children and



















school students). The main clients and projects (participation in calls for tenders; participation in national and European R&D Projects with multidisciplinary partners; collaboration with Salento University and other national Research Centres; collaboration with local authorities such as municipalities, regions and public archaeological services such as the Italian Ministry of Culture; direct commissions) and some examples of activities such as the *Apulia Cultural Identity Paths* (a project funded by the Italian Ministry of Education and University, for the creation of cultural paths in Puglia region focusing on the cultural heritage in connection with typical food and wines of Southern Italy) were presented to the lecturers. The second part of the lesson included the description of the ancient settlement of Rudiae and of the main results from the excavation of the amphitheater and the promotion activities of ancient Rudiae in collaboration with the local authorities: virtual tours, guided tours with an archaeologist, cultural projects with high school students (for example reproduction of ancient objects), theatrical guided tours, theatrical and musical performances in the amphitheater arena, organization of summer schools and archaeological workshops, organization of contemporary art exhibitions, cultivation of olive trees in the archaeological park.

At the end of the meeting, they expressed positive feedbacks about the lecture. They requested the sharing of the ppt presentation. Before and after the meeting, the trainees were informed about the progressive steps of the schedule and invited to the next meetings.

LESSON 5 (10th February 2021, at 3 pm Iraqi time)

Title: Training on how to design a start-up project: ARTSTORIES

Trainer/s: Dr. Giovanna Hirsch and Dr. Federica Pascotto (Artstories S.r.l/Associazione Culturale Bartolomeo).

Aim of the lesson: the meetig aimed at the presentation of the activities of an Italian successful startup which works in the development of educational apps which illustrate and show to the children art and history by non-conventional tools (such as didactic games and practical activities).

Description: during the meeting, the trainers illustrated some innovative procedures for the cultural heritage enhancement by educational and didactic tools (*how to disseminate the cultural heritage*?)

The lesson was divided into two sections: in the first part, the ppt presentation included the social and educational relevance of heritage, the importance of communicating cultural heritage to younger generations and of creating educational and cultural experiences, the necessity of making collections easy to access to any public, the importance of identification of the audience of any cultural event (schools, foreign tourists, scholars, local tourists, elderly visitors, families, groups from abroad, local groups), the difference between the traditional ways of communication (explanations, titles and themes, guided tours, captions, leaflets, maps, workshops), digital ways (online collections, multimedia design, audio tours, video games, website, informative apps, VR/AR), and online ways (Instagram, Facebook, TikTok, podcasts, virtual tours and websites). According to the trainers' opinion, all these products, which aim at engaging visitors online and offline, need to be used for the cultural communication. Some Italian and international examples of innovative tools for connecting users and museums realities were presented to the trainees: concerning the virtual reality, Modigliani, The Ocre Studio (Tate Modern), Ara Pacis (Rome), M9 Mestre (Venice), Cooper Hewitt Museum (New York); concerning the informative apps, the cases of MoMa and Louvre; concerning the cultural video games, the examples of Father and son (MANN Museo Archeologico Nazionale, Napoli) and Past for future (MARTA, Museo Archeologico Taranto); concerning the educational videos, the animated paintings (Prado Museum, Madrid) and the MetKids (Metropolitan Museum, New York). In the second part of the meeting, the trainers showed the procedures of creation of ArtStories (educational apps and digital tools on cultural heritage for kids 4+), the mission of ArtStories, that is the promotion of the sense of beauty and the sense of history to foster curiosity and to empower observation among young children, and presented the main apps/digital games (Il Castello Sforzesco (Milan); Duomo (Milan); Ancient Egypt; Cities), further cultural activities (organization of workshops and creative ateliers in public libraries, schools



















and museums) and the main collaborations (Milan Municipality -Palazzo Marino Kids app; The UNESCO sites in Varese -Sacro Monte app; Bolzano Municipality -Arte e Sport app; Veneranda Fabbrica del Duomo -Art stories Milan Duomo app; Childrens' Museum of Milan -World Food app).

FINAL RESULTS

Title: *Drafting of startup projects*

Description: Final draft of the startups projects (12 startup projects) by the groups who were involved in the trainings and workshops, and presentation of the startup projects as posters to the academic and wider community at the 12th ICAANE conference at the University of Bologna (deadline: 25 march 2021, Title of the project: *Entrepreneurship on the field of cultural heritage (BANUU)*). Moreover, the academic staff members and students participated as listeners in the conference scheduled speeches: a personal account to access the conference (period: 6th-9th April 2021) was activated for each group.

- all professors and students involved in the elaboration of the startups projects;
- all universities representatives and contact persons involved in the organization of WP4.

A list of the startup projects (posters) was made available online in order to draw attention to the startups projects and find sponsors for their real business development.

After the conference, the participants received the feedbacks of the ICAANE international community about their proposals in order to improve their startups concepts.
