15th January 2020, Wednesday

Morning session

The Banuu kick-off meeting was held in the Jadriyah campus in the main building of the University of Baghdad for its beginning with salutations. The meeting was opened by the **welcome speeches** by the Presidents of the Universities of Baghdad, Kufa and Al-Qadisiyah and the Vice President of Mosul University and the representatives of the following institutions: Italian Embassy; Delegation of the European Union; Ministry of Higher Education of Scientific Research of Iraq; Ministry of Culture, Tourism and Antiquities of Iraq – SBAH. The final welcome speech was delivered by the Banuu coordinator on behalf of the University of Bologna. A ceremony was held by the President of Baghdad University giving some gifts to his esteemed guests. The assembly then proceeds to move to the Presidency Building, top floor for the business meeting.

Prof. Nicolò Marchetti, scientific coordinator of the project, presents the **Banuu general objectives** and expected outcomes (Attachment 1a). After this presentation, Nicolò Marchetti and Federico Zaina from the UNIBO coordination team provided details on the **Banuu workplan** with particular regards to the description of **Work Packages 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 (Attachments 1b and 2)**.

After these presentation, a tour de table was held allowing all the partners to introduce themselves and their expectations towards the Banuu project.

The last presentation of the morning was given by Nicolò Marchetti (University of Bologna), Rawaa Qasha (University of Mosul) and Habeeb Herez Allawi (Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research) about the **WP1 activities: "Analysis of issues and needs"** (Attachment 3). After the presentation, all the partners gave their feedbacks helping to better frame the WP1 tasks, in particular the WP1 task-forces were preliminarily defined a deadline for their establishment was fixed for the end of January.

A <u>lunch</u> is then offered by the President of the University of Baghdad to his guests.

Afternoon session

During the afternoon session, the project members Prof. Çiğdem Maner (Koç University of Istanbul) and Prof. Carlo Lippolis (CRAST) presented the WPs that they will co-lead respectively. In particular Prof. Çiğdem Maner presented **WP2 - Internships framing** (Attachment 4) while Prof. Lippolis presented **WP4 - Activities for Students' Entrepreneurship** (Attachment 5).

Management of the Banuu project (Attachment 6). The detailed budget of each partner has been presented together with the expected deadlines for transfer of funds. In particular, the Coordinator highlighted that the Staff costs must be mandatorily transferred to the institutional bank accounts of the Partner Universities after the completion of the related WPs and the provision of all the necessary supporting documents. The Iraqi partners communicated to the other partners the problems they are facing in opening the institutional bank accounts. Upon request of the Iraqi Partners, Prof. Marchetti as project coordinator will immediately request a meeting with H.E. the Minister of Higher Education in order to discuss and find possible solutions. In particular, the following two options will be discussed with H.E. the Minister himself:

Option 1: The MOHESR supports the Iraqi Partner Universities in opening institutional bank accounts that can receive funds from abroad;

Option 2: All the funds of the Iraqi Partner Universities will be transferred to the MOHESR institutional bank account and then the MOHESR will be in charge of transferring the funds to the Universities in a timely and precisely targeted way;

The Partners will be updated on the progress of this issue as the meeting takes place.¹

The Coordinator also provided the partners with specific administrative management rules for the equipment and travel/stay costs budget headings. In particular:

- The equipment to be purchased must be dedicated to set up specific internship offices in the Iraqi Universities: computers, print and scan machines, software, books on Preventive Archaeology, Cultural Heritage Management and Cultural Tourism. Deviations from the proposed equipment are possible but need to be proposed and approved by the European Union beforehand;
- Travel and Stay costs for the Iraqi Partners will be managed directly by the Coordinator in order to facilitate the administrative procedures and reporting. Staff members/students must arrive one day before the initial working day and depart the day after the last working day. Moreover, staff members can travel only from the location of their institutions to the location of the hosting institution. Finally, flight tickets cannot be changed once they have been purchased. These rules are those of the EU which strictly enforces them.

During the WP7 presentation, the following issues were discussed and approved by the Banuu project team according to the following agenda for the period of February – July 2020:
