



1. My home university/institution







- 3. Content: WP2 and WP4 (1 = strongly agree, 4 = strongly disagree)


a. The feed-back on the WP2:4 assignment (Student/Teacher groups) was useful and applicable. ($Medel=1,4,\ SD=0,9$)




b. The presentations on internationalization at University of Cologne and Ghent University were useful and applicable. (Medel = 1,4, SD = 0,6)

d. The training the last day with Fiona Hunter was useful. (Medel = 1,0, SD = 0,3)





- My special thanks goes to Fiona as I come to to know how to start an IR office and what it is for. [a: 2, b: 2, c: 2, d: 1]




- Fiona is a very good trainer and I've learned a lot from her . [a: 2, b: 2, c: 2, d: 1]
