


#### AFRICAN CENTRE FOR FOOD SECURITY (ACFS)



- The African Centre for Food Security (ACFS): conceived of in the late 1990s following University of KwaZulu-Natal (UKZN) after a Conference in Zambia on the topic and need for Food and Nutrition Security education.
- VISION: the ACFS offer nationally & internationally unique and innovative transdisciplinary education and research opportunities to develop capacity for teaching, research and collaborative community engagement related to food and nutrition security and sustainable food systems.
- The ACFS is now a "CORE Partner" of the ARUA's COE on Sustainable Food Systems.

#### CAPACITY BUILDING & RESEARCH

- Post Grad Diploma & Coursework Masters,
   Research Masters & PhD's, Short Courses (FNS)
- Collaborative (communities, researchers, government, private sector, NGOs and other development agencies, individuals: student/researcher as "change agent": Social
- Participatory Research (Social, Gender, Empowerment/Agency, Economic, Environmental/Agricultural/Climate/ Food Environments)
- Interventionist approach transform the system



# Example: Water safety, produce safety (FNS Pillar: Access, Avail, Utilization)

 Objective: assess water quality, safety, risk and access for urban producers

Results: <u>fresh river water</u> analysis demonstrated that uMsunduzi Rivrer <u>consistently exceeded the recommended</u> <u>water quality, VS stored river water was of</u> higher quality due to <u>innovative</u> farmer practices may serve as a replacement. (long sun exposure:
