ABSTRACT

This short course delves into the core design choices and social processes undergirding work group efficacy, with special reference to peculiarities of co-located and virtual teams. In particular, the construction of social norms, development of an appropriate degree of cohesiveness, and decision making processes will be parsed out with the support of organizational instances.
