Claudia Golino is Full Professor since 2020, she's Head of Sociology and Business Law Department, member of the University Senate, and teaches Law and Economics and Social Services Law. She carries out her main research on topics focused on public intervention in the economy, at european and internal level, and in specific sectors as public services, professional organizations, public finance, economic and local development. She has participated in many national and international conferences, and has published in several journals (Rivista Trimestrale di Diritto Pubblico, Rivista trimestrale di Diritto dell'Economia, Jus, Federalismi, Percorsi Costituzionali) and is author of three books (Ordini e Collegi professionali nel mercato. Riflessioni sul modello di ente pubblico professionale; Il principio del pareggio di bilancio. Evoluzione e prospettive; L'intervento pubblico per lo sviluppo economico delle aree depresse tra mercato e solidarietà).

**Carlo Tovo** is Référendaire (Legal Secretary) at the European Court of Justice, in the chambers of Judge L. S. Rossi. He has been adjunct and visiting professor of EU law and EU internal market law in France, Italy and China and he has intervened as speaker and discussant in various conferences and workshops throughout Europe. In the framework of his research on the EU institutional framework, he has published a monograph on 'EU decentralized agencies' (in Italian) and he has coordinated the Young Researchers Platform of the Academic Research Network on EU Executive Governance (TARN).

In 2016 he won the R. Monaco Prize for the best PhD thesis in EU law from the Italian Society of International Law and European Union Law.
