## ABSTRACT

The Ever Given accident, which took place some weeks ago in the Suez Canal, provided evidence of the potentially disruptive effects of a maritime accident, in the globalized economy, if it takes place in one of the “bottle-necks” of the worldwide maritime transport network. The emergency is over. Now it is important to focus on the possible involvement of SME, as maritime transport users, in the costs deriving from such accident and on the possibility for them to obtain compensation for the damages suffered as its consequence, on the ground of the applicable international liability regime.
