► Public Institution


Decision making authority

- ► Land work
- emptying the ships
- Emptying containers
- fees of ships' docking



Harbor's Master

- ► Unit of General Directorate of Land & Marine Transportation
- Responsible of the harbors' water part



Harbor's Master



- ▶ Daily coordination with the Directorate for the use of harbor's water
- ► The ships anchor location, sedimentation management, ships registration
