- Harbors are public institutions in Lebanon
- Four main harbors in Lebanon
- Each one of it has its own financial and administrative independence



Tripoli Harbor's management

- ▶ Two different identities :
 - ▶ Exploitation Office
 - ▶ Harbor Master



Exploitation's Office

- ▶ Public Institution
 - ▶ Decision making authority
 - ▶ Executive authority



Exploitation's Office

- ▶ Land work
- ▶ emptying the ships
- ▶ Emptying containers
- ▶ fees of ships' docking



Harbor's Master

- ▶ Unit of General Directorate of Land & Marine Transportation
- ▶ Responsible of the harbors' water part



Harbor's Master



- ▶ Daily coordination with the Directorate for the use of harbor's water
- ▶ The ships anchor location, sedimentation management, ships registration
