- Occasional bursts in activities

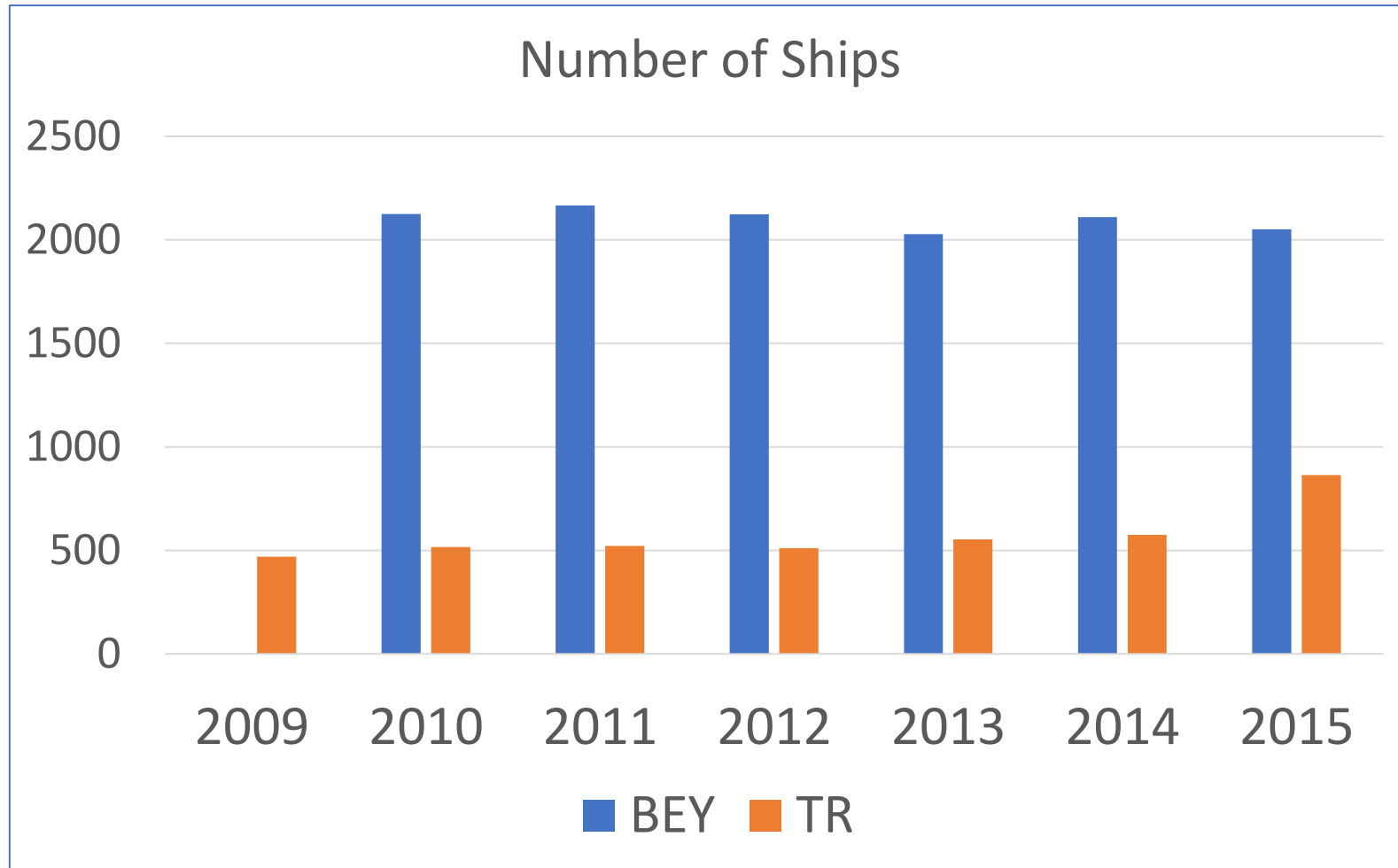
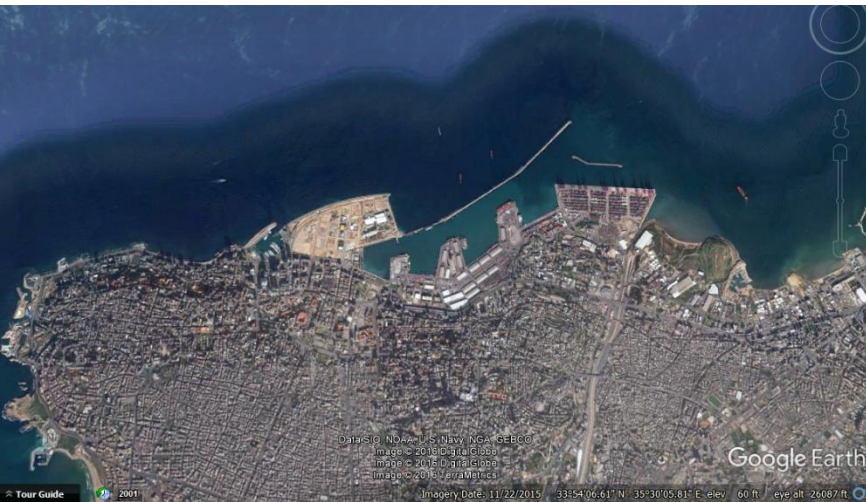


# The Port of Tripoli in numbers

- 2<sup>nd</sup> Maritime access in Lebanon
- Area about 3 million Square meter
- Bassin 1.5 Mm<sup>2</sup>
- Land 950,000 m<sup>2</sup>
- SEZ area 550,000 m<sup>2</sup>

- Annual Income \$2M \*\*

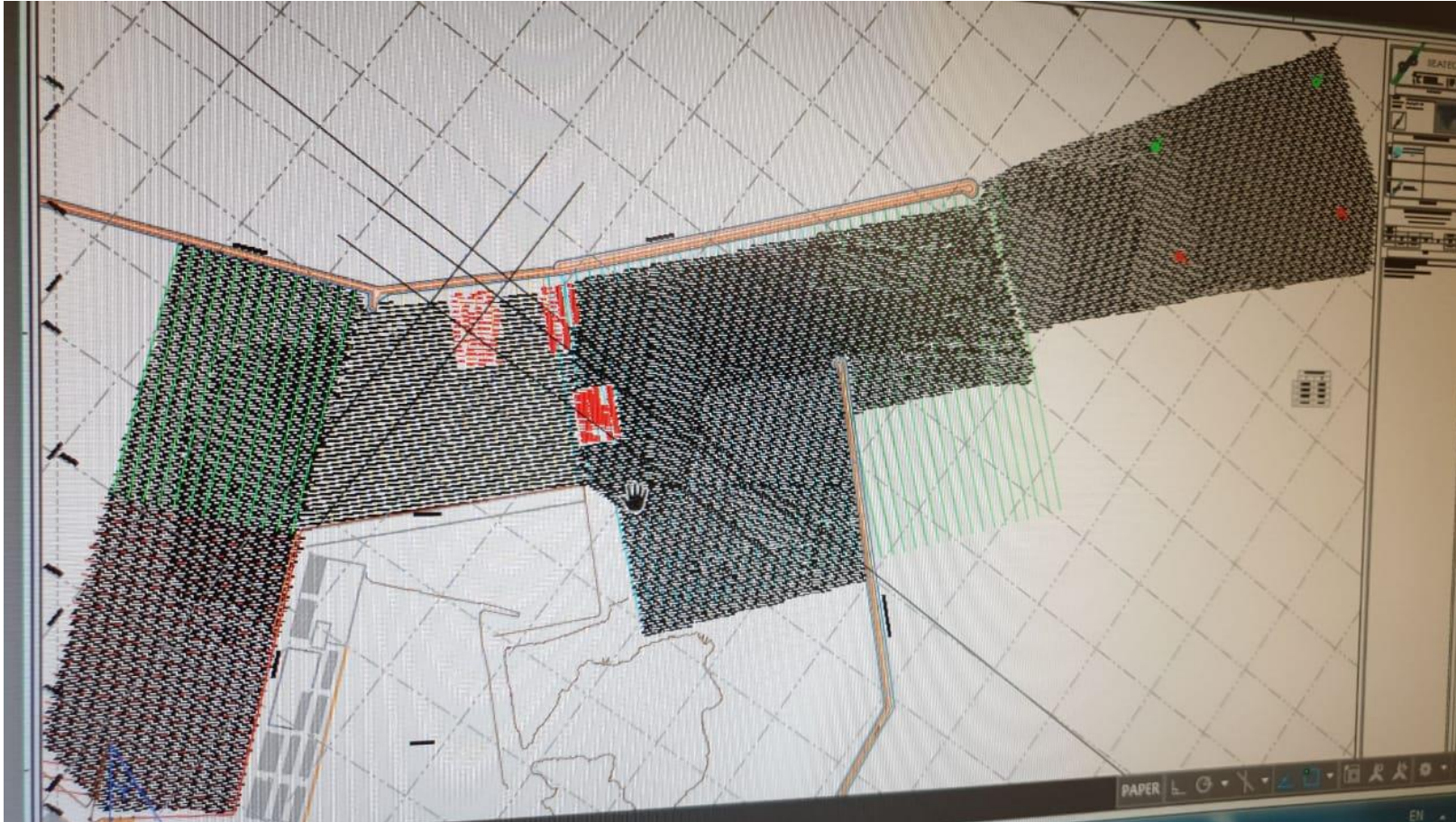

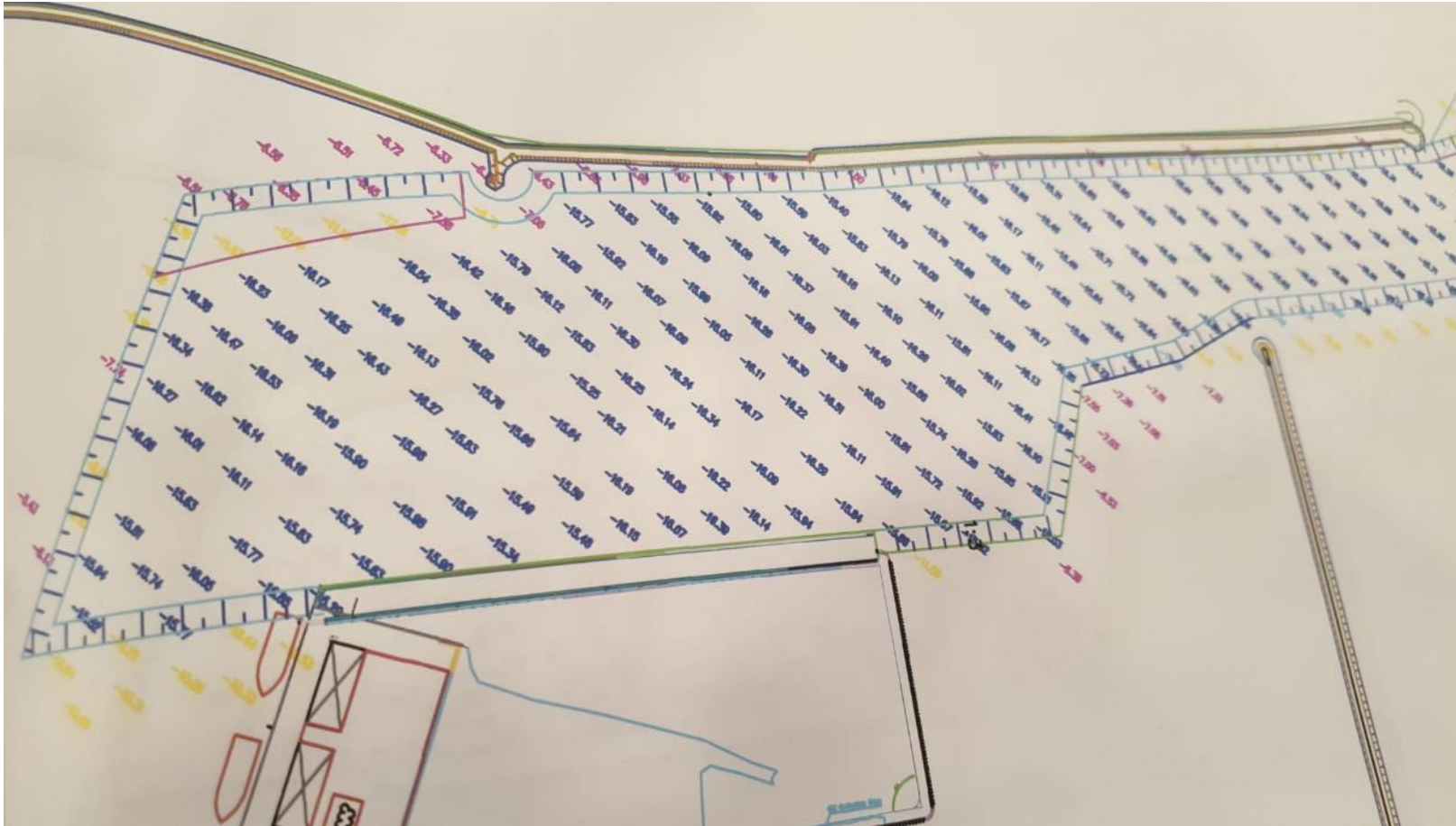
