

What is all about?

> Basis:

Dispute over the maritime economic zones as part of Cyprus-dispute.

> Intensification:

May 2019, Turkey's first drilling activities in Cyprus' EEZ.

Formally, EU gets behind its member state Cyprus



Policy outputs

Foreign Affairs Council (15/07/2019)

- Suspension of negotiations on the Comprehensive Air Transport Agreement.
- Suspension of meetings of the Association Council and EU -Turkey high-level dialogues.
- European Investment Bank invited to review its lending activities.

Foreign Affairs Council (11/11/2019)

 Adoption of framework for restrictive measures: travel ban + assetfreeze for individuals or entities.

Statement of the members of the European Council (25/03/2021)

- "Double Track Approach"
- Engagement to enhance cooperation in several areas of common interest


