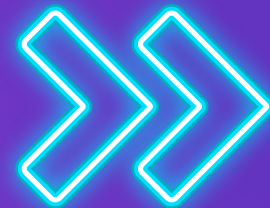

1. **Questions with multiple answers;**
2. **Simulations of social networks' online behaviours and ethical selection of options;**
3. **Recognition of types of disinformation;**
4. **Recognition of visual features into texts, photos and videos to make users question the reliability of the information;**
5. **Recognition of para-textual markers coming along with texts, photos and videos (mainly in social networks and websites) in order to make users question the reliability of the sources;**
6. **Simulations of lateral reading practices;**
7. **Verification of understanding the impact of disinformation on society.**
