

The conference Environmental Challenges in Premodern Eurasian and Mediterranean Narratives, a unique scholarly opportunity for interdisciplinary collaboration, aims to explore how the attitude towards environmental challenges, natural disasters, and calamities might be affected by contextual factors related to the socio-political scenario, ideological trajectories, or religious beliefs. The conference, covering the pre-modern era, focuses on the MENA region, the Mediterranean, and Europe. It gathers distinguished scholars from Europe, the MENA region, and the US to explore a wide range of thematic issues, from the challenges of mapping, reconstructing, and studying diverse sets of epistemic and ideological views used to phenomena, environmental the to different conceptualizations of the relationship between humans and nature across time and place.



The conference is convened under the EU-granted project (NextGenerationEU - PRIN 2022): "Environmental Anomalies & Political Legitimacy in Global Eurasia, 12th-14th century." The project results from an inter-university collaboration between "L' Orientale" University of Naples, Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna, and Calabria University.
