# 1. Background

## 1.1. Methodology

## 1.2. Stakeholder mapping objective

The stakeholder mapping will be used for various communication purposes including but not limited to sending invitations to attend MyLocalFoodE -related events, invitations to subscribe to FoodE's press release, conducting surveys and engagement via social media.

The list will provide a global view of the landscape of stakeholders engaged remotely or very closely with FoodE's scope and objectives. It will allow understanding and assessing their sentiment towards local food initiatives and will serve as a key source of intelligence to enhance FoodE's communication efforts. The document will be continuously updated throughout the project.

## 1.3. Stakeholder mapping geographical scope
