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- **Food systems approach**
- **Targeted, conditional funding** for agroecological transitions and rural livelihoods
- **Market and procurement structures** favouring small sustainable producers, short supply chains, farmers' markets
- **Technical assistance, training, and social protection** for transitioning farmers
- **Strengthened environmental and animal welfare legislation + mirror measures** for imports to the EU market
- **Supply-chain transparency and accountability**
- **Clear labelling and marketing reforms** for fairly-priced, biodiversity-supporting food
