

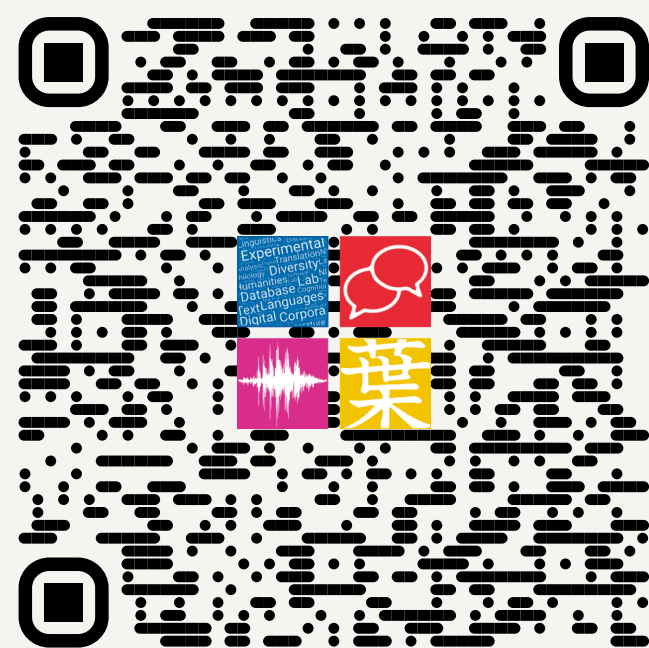


Conducting priming experiments with PCIBex

After a brief introduction to the concept of priming, this tutorial will provide a hands-on guide for designing and running priming studies using PCIBex (<https://farm.pcibex.net>), a free web-based experiment platform. Specifically, I will show you how to customize existing experiment templates to create your own priming study and collect data with ease.
