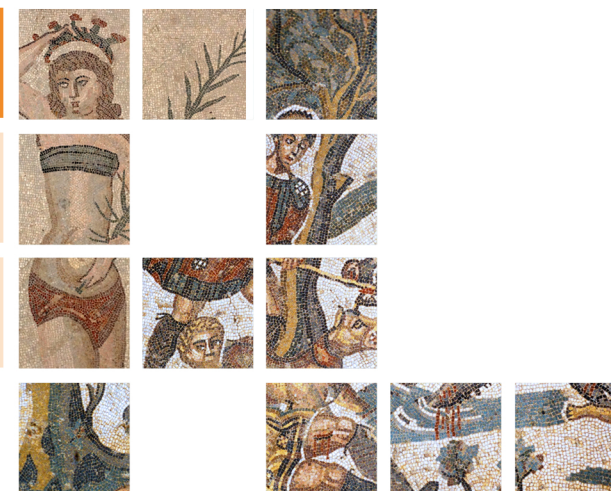

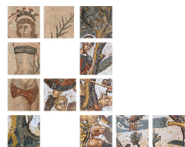

Description: The Summer School will deal with housing in late antique Sicily, with particular focus on the aristocratic villa of Piazza Armerina. It takes an approach based on digital techniques for investigation, data collection, and data management for archaeological practice and research. The aim of the programme is to provide a learning opportunity that combines theory with practice adopting the whole range of state-of-the-art methodologies suitable for archaeology. It will be held in the exceptional context of the Villa of Piazza Armerina, one of the most famous archaeological sites of the Mediterranean, which will be used as a teaching model of excellence. The project is part of the activities of CISEM – Centro Interuniversitario di Studi sull’Edilizia abitativa tardoantica nel Mediterraneo (<https://centri.unibo.it/cisem/it>), in collaboration with the Parco Archeologico di Morgantina e Villa Romana del Casale and the University of South Florida. The expected number of incoming students from abroad is 18 and 6 students from UNIBO will participate in the fieldwork, too.
