

## **Ludovica Mulas short bio**

Ludovica Mulas, Re-Globe Researcher Assistant, is a PhD candidate in International Economic Law at the University of Bologna (Italy) under the supervision of Prof. Elisa Baroncini and at the Universität Göttingen (Germany) under the supervision of Prof. Peter-Tobias Stoll. She is also tutor for the Jessup Moot Court Competition and for the International Law course of the University of Bologna in Ravenna.

She graduated in Law at the University of Bologna with a thesis in International Trade and Investment Law titled “*The Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA) and its Problematic Implementation: A Legal Analysis*”.

Ludovica studied at the University Paris 1 Pantheon-Sorbonne within the Erasmus Exchange Program, moreover she spent a six-month research period abroad at the University of Göttingen under the supervision of Prof. Peter-Tobias Stoll and a four-month research period abroad at the University of Geneva, where she worked under the supervision of Prof. Gabrielle Marceau, Senior Counsellor in the Legal Affairs Division of the World Trade Organization (WTO).

She held seminars on Public International Law and International Trade and Investment Law and published several papers and articles on the financial services regime and prudential regulation.
