

The Journey of Gandhi –From South Africa to Indian Independence

- Gandhi's train ejection: The story begins on June 7, 1893, when a young Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi is thrown off a train in South Africa for being in a whites-only compartment despite holding a valid first-class ticket. He had stayed the whole night at the station in a cold waiting room.
- The seed for 'Satyagraha' (Non Violent Resistance) was planted.
- 21 years in SA shaped his philosophy of peace and non-violence.








1915 : Gandhi's Return to India

- National movement based on nonviolent resistance and civil disobedience.
- Salt March 1930: Nonviolent civil disobedience, the Nonviolent march of 240 miles against absurd salt rule.
- Numoerous arrest
- Freedom from British rule.




Gandhi's Thought
