












How to Apply

The International Graduate Program in our graduate school follows a four-quarter system with Autumn, Winter, Spring and Summer terms.


Master's course begins in the autumn term starting in October (October Entry).

(Note that the Japanese taught standard course begins in the spring term (April Entry))

Doctoral course begins in either the autumn term (October Entry) or the spring term (April Entry).

You can apply as a self-funded student or for a scholarship to study in our graduate school. If you want to apply for the Japanese Government Scholarship, MEXT (Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science, and Technology) scholarship, there are two ways: MEXT (embassy recommended) and MEXT (university selection). MEXT (embassy recommended) is available for Master's and PhD programs, and the application should be submitted through your local Japanese embassy or consulate. MEXT (university selection), for which we have eight places available, is only for the PhD program in our graduate school, and the application should be submitted directly to us. The Faculty of Agriculture also offers up to two scholarships for the PhD program that are available for all non-Japanese nationals, even for those who live in Japan. For the Master's program, we have ADB-JSP scholarships for those who are nationals of ADB borrowing member countries and meet all the eligibility conditions. Another scholarship option for the Master's program is a JDS scholarship. Currently, we accept JDS scholars from Viet Nam, Myanmar, Laos, and Ghana. Note that the application/selection schedules are different for each scholarship.





1. PhD Research Scholarship



Priority 1. Southeast Asian nationals who are enrolled in PhD programs in any of the member universities under the <u>Southeast Asian University</u> <u>Consortium for Graduate Education in Agriculture and Natural Resources (UC)¹</u>.

Priority 2. Southeast Asian nationals who are regular staff members of government agencies or non-profit develo

government agencies or non-profit development are PhD students of agricultural university.

Application Procedure

Applicants must fill out online the <u>SEARCA PhD Research Scholarship</u> <u>application form</u>

The required documents:

- 1.Letter of application for the research scholarship which should be addressed to the **SEARCA Director**;
- 2.Official endorsement from the employer (if employed);
- **3.Recommendation letter from the Dean of Graduate School** of the university where the applicant is pursuing the degree program;
- 4. Dissertation research **outline/proposal approved** by the Advisory Committee and Dean of Graduate School;
- **5.Budgetary** requirement for the entire research duly attested and recommended by the major adviser and Dean of Graduate School;
- 6. True copy of **grades** for courses taken;
- 7.Letter from the applicant certifying that he/she is not receiving any other research grant from any other institution.
- **8.Research timetable** indicating the activities involved in the research and the expected date of defense which should not exceed one year.





2. DAAD-SEARCA Scholarship Programme

- As of Academic Year 2021/2022, DAAD and SEARCA have awarded 19
 Cambodians, 90 Indonesians, 9 Laotians, 14 Malaysians, 27 Myanmar nationals, 96 Filipinos, 82 Thais, 26 Timorese, and 45 Vietnamese.
- Among the 408 Southeast Asian awardees, 198 pursued their MS, 205 pursued PhD, and 5 enrolled for Non-degree.



Eligibility



- Nationals of SEAMEO member countries who are employees of academic or research institutions or government agencies (priority is given to regular employees).
- Must not be more than 35 (Master's Degree) or 40 (PhD) years of age at the time of application.
- Have completed their last university degree not more than 6 years ago at the time of application.

3. Tokyo University of Agriculture-SEARCA Scholarship



for Dissertation Doctorate Program

- A collaborative project between Tokyo University of Agriculture (Tokyo NODAI) and SEARCA.
- Effective Academic Year 2020-2021 for a duration of three years (until AY 2022-2023), the scholarship provides **one slot** annually for a three-year graduate program leading to a Dissertation Doctorate at Tokyo NODAI.
- The scholarship is open only to nationals of the regular member countries of the Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO).

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

institution;

- •Holder of a master's degree in agriculture or related fields;
- •Has produced at **least three (3) peer-reviewed scientific papers** in scholarly journals in applicant's country or abroad and has served first author of at least one of those papers;
- •Must have already made a substantial progress in a research project which will deserve a doctorate degree in three years; and
- •Not more than 48 years of age at the start of the program.

Application and Selection Procedure

Toolhit cation requirements must be submitted by 30 March of every years university

2. SEARCA does the **preliminary screening** and selection of candidates and forwards a shortlist of candidates to Tokyo NODAI **on or before 30 April of**

every year.

- 3. The Tokyo NODAI makes the final selection of one awardee and appoints suitable adviser for the candidate; Tokyo NODAI then informs SEARCA of the final awardee and his/her assigned supervisor on or before the end of May, every year.
- 4. The SEARCA GSID informs the successful candidate immediately. The scholarship awardee will start his/her study program in July of every year.



Application Requirements



- 1.Original or certified true copy of academic records
- 2. Certification of employment;
- 3.A recommendation letter from employer;
- 4. Updated curriculum vitae;
- 5. priority **research topics must fall** within the ATTAIN priority areas:
- 6. Two copies of passport-size photo of the applicant;
- 7. Certification from a medical doctor
- 8. Proofs of at least three peer-reviewed scientific papers published





Project Duration

- Effective Academic Year 2020-2021, the scholarship project will award one scholar per year for a period of three years (until AY 2022-2023).

4. Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM)-SEARCA Joint Scholarship

- The joint project between Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) and SEARCA started in 2012 and has been renewed under a new structure for another five academic years, starting September 2020 until August 2025.
- 2 years for Master and 3 years for PhD







- •nationals of SEAMEO member countries who are employees of academic or research institutions or government agencies (priority is given to regular employees).
- •Must not be more than 35 (Master's Degree) or 40 (PhD) years of age at the time of application.
- •Proposed thesis research should focus on SEARCA's overarching theme of <u>Accelerating Transformation Through</u> <u>Agricultural Innovation (ATTAIN)</u>.



Application Procedure



Applicants must fill out the **UPM-SEARCA Joint Scholarship Form**

The required documents:

- 1.Original/certified true copy of transcript of academic records
- 2.Original or certified true copies of certificates of completion/diploma for every degree completed
- 3. Certificate of employment
- 4.Endorsement from the employer
- 5. Updated curriculum vitae
- 6.The research topic must be in line with SEARCA's overarching theme of <u>Accelerating Transformation Through Agricultural Innovation (ATTAIN)</u>.
- 7.Certification from a medical doctor and 8. <u>IELTS</u> results of 6.0 or <u>TOEFL iBT</u> result of 75



5. Sejong University-SEARCA Joint Graduate Research



Scholarship for Southeast Asian Countries

A Joint Graduate Research Scholarship that will enable them to obtain MS/PhD degrees

- -Integrated Biological Sciences and Industry (e.g., Plant Breeding and Genetics),
- Bioresource Engineering (e.g., Plant pathology, QTL mapping, Tissue culture). Nationals of the regular member countries of the Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO), who are junior and mid-level executives, managers, researchers, or technical staff of government or non-governmental agencies and universities.
- •Must not be more than 35 (Master's Degree) or 40 (PhD) years of age at the time of application;

Application and Selection Procedure

Applicants must fill out online the Sejong UniversityJoint Graduate Research Scholarship Application Form

The **required documents** to be submitted

- 1.Original/certified true copy of transcript
- 2.Original or certified true copies of certificates of completion
- 3. Certificate of employment
- 4.Endorsement/Recommendation from employer
- 5. Updated curriculum vitae
- 6.Brief description (one to two pages only) of the proposed research and
- Two copies of passport-size photo of the applicant
- 7. Copy of applicant's passport biopage
- 8.Certification from a medical doctor and 9. Proof of English proficiency





Shortlisted applicants will be interviewed online by Sejong University advisors. Only those who will be accepted by the advisors shall be instructed to apply for admission at Sejong University.

- Transcripts
- Certificate of Graduation
- •Copy of the applicant's parents' passports (can be replaced by any official document stating the parents' nationality)
- •An **official document** that shows the parent-child relationship between the applicant and his/her parents (e.g. birth certificate)

To be awarded the scholarship, applicants must both have a **Sejong University professor** as advisor and an **approved admission to their chosen degree** program.





6. NTU-SEARCA Joint Scholarship Program for Global ATGS

This is a partnership between the Master Program in Global Agriculture
 Technology and Genomic Science (Global ATGS) of the National Taiwan
 University (NTU) and SEARCA. The joint scholarship program aims to cultivate agricultural professional talents, encourage academic excellence, and promote research and development of agriculture within Southeast Asia.

 The scholarship is open to nationals of the regular member countries of the Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO)
