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

- List of exchange students, learning agreements, transcripts of records in the local database




Disadvantages





CRITERIA:

- ✓ Proportion of International degree seeking students
- ✓ Proportion of international exchange students
- ✓ Proportion of students going for studies/ research/ internship abroad
- ✓ Number of students who get support from the faculty

The goal:
Bilingual environment of Study Information System and services

At least B1 language level of non-academic staff

Professional development

Students' satisfaction with studies

Collaboration with international social partners

International teachers' satisfaction with internationalisation at the faculty

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Study Internationalization assessment methodology

- 5 levels of each criteria
- Points are allocated for achievement in each level
- Once the higher level is achieved it automatically means that lower level requirements have been fulfilled
