Main tasks

- Checking foreign Bachelor's Degrees
 - booked appointments
 - master students



Credential evaluation: Who can apply?

- Students returning from exchange abroad
- International students
- Foreign exchange students



Credit transfer: processing the application

- Online application
- Only students admitted to Uppsala university may apply!
- Course descriptions + Transcript of Records required
- Only passed courses are transferred
- Only transfer of credits, not grades



Challenges

- Credit transfer: very different education systems!
- How many hours/credits = fulltime studies?



Two types of Degrees:

- Professional Degrees (Degree in Civil Engineering, Medical Degree,...)
- General Degrees (Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree)



- Bachelor's Degree (180 credits)
 - 3 years of study
- Master's Degree (60 credits or 120 credits)
 - 1 or 2 years of study



- Bachelor's Degree:
 - 180 credits in total
 - 30 credits/semester
 - -1 semester = 20 weeks
 - Main + second area of study



- Master's Degree:
 - 120 credits in total

At least 60 credits in main area of study



The credit transfer process

- 1. Online application → Registration and examination,
 verification of the transcript of Records
- 2. Credit evaluator → Which subject? How many Swedish credits?
- 3. Decision → letter to applicant, registration of courses



After the credit transfer

- Student may appeal our decision
- Courses are registered
- Courses can be included in a degree
