




• All participants of the project consortium have responded to the questionnaire

Infrastructure and organization


I was satisfied with the quality of communication and interaction between partners before the meeting


The time for meeting was a bit late for Laotian partners as the meeting last until 5 PM, which is the time for those who have children to pick up their children from school.

Since it was my first experience with Google team, it took few minutes for me to join the meeting. But it was a nice experience as an international team.


Content: Fourth Consortium Meeting – Online Meeting

• <u>Almost all (90%) of respondents had proposed that the new project timeline and objectives</u> were useful and clear, with 1/3rd of this group in strong agreement.


The presentations on the rescheduled activities for WP3 and WP4 were useful and applicable 10 responses



• A similar percentage of participants (as above) have answerd that the rescheduled activities for WP3 and WP4 were useful and applicble.


The presentation of WP2 closing activities and division of tasks among the Consortium was clear and useful

Thank you arranging this virtual meeting, and if it is manageable, I would like to request to hold another meeting through Zoom application.


No comment.

It was a great opportunity to discuss the new issues and challenges related to conducting planned activities.


Results

• According to the responses, 80% of participants had understood how to proceed with the WP2 activities, with 30% of respondents agreeing strongly. The other 20% of participants had indicated a neutral position to this question.


It was clear to me how to complete the procedure of equipment purchase 10 responses



• For 90% of all respondents, (50% strong agreement) it had been clear to them on how to complete the procedure of equipment purchase.

• <u>70% of participants have positively responded that they were clear on how to work with interim</u> report and their responsibilities in the consortium. However, 30% of participants have not recorded a clear understanding of this fact, as evident in the comments section to this question.
