Mobility in Emergency – Turning a challenge into an opportunity



Successful and well structured
 Physical Mobility Programs

According to the latest data (academic year 2018/2019), the students of the University of Bologna who left on Erasmus were 2,963: <u>the highest number among</u> <u>European universities.</u> As far as incoming students are concerned, the University of Bologna is second in Europe with 2,537 incoming students. • Virtual and Blended Moblity experiences

Virtual mobility was tested mainly in the departments within some Strategic Partnerships projects (which included Intensive Blended Programs). There was not a structured strategy, it was mainly a <u>bottom up approach</u>

Mobility in Emergency – Turning a challenge into an opportunity



Online mobility - partner universities open their online teaching offer also to students enrolled in the other UNA Europa universities. – <u>ALREADY TWO EDITIONS</u>



Blended mobility - same as the first one, but at the end of the semester each partner university organises some activities in presence involving students and professors – <u>NOT YET POSSIBLE</u>



Joint design of teaching units - Teachers will organize common teaching activities for their classes assuring forms of interaction among students attending the teaching units (joint virtual laboratories; joint working groups, etc.) – <u>ONE EDITION and SECOND COMING</u>

Seed Funding – New ideas in all disciplinary fields




Una Europa launches an **annual call for applications** for seed funding. The aim of the seed funding initiative is to support the initiation of long-term collaborative activities between the partner universities.

- working to further strengthen the research and innovation (R&I) aspect of Una Europa, in synergy with the education aspects
- taking the first steps towards creating a common R&I eco-system for our researchers and partners > enable barrier-free collaboration, sharing of infrastructure, knowledge, resources, involving local communities and non-academic partners, between staff and researchers from all Una Europa universities
- creating a **University of the Future** as an international, value-driven, innovative, open and inclusive community of researchers, students and professional services
- setting the **global standard** for international research collaboration and education

Objectives



- transform the institutional framework of Una Europa member institutions to prepare for the next wave of global challenges and make research more interdisciplinary and international
- to pool our collective research strengths, infrastructure and resources, by developing shared strategies, priorities and agendas, to scale our interdisciplinary excellence and tackle society's biggest challenges together
- to develop a vision of a value-driven common research culture, that prioritises excellence, wellbeing, integration and diversity
- to develop frameworks that involve citizens and non-academic actors across all regions of our eco-system, in all stages of the R&I lifecycle (Open Research)
- to work towards our objectives in collaboration with other European University Alliances, sharing experiences and learning from each other

The steps


 Identification of barriers to seamless collaboration and sharing and enablers of R&I cooperation

- Development of shared Strategies and Action Plans in consultation with Una Europa R&I stakeholders through workshops and online surveys:
 - R&I Strategy
 - Sharing Research Infrastructure & Resources Strategy
 - Human Capital Strategy
- **Pilot actions** e.g. models to accelerate cross-disciplinary and cross-sectoral collaboration, innovative formats to widen sharing of research infrastructure and resources, innovative formats on human capital development for interlocking research activities with the broader university ecosystem
- Evaluation of pilots and dissemination of lessons learned for scaling them to other Higher Education Institutions

Expected impacts




1. identification of successful models for modernization and transformation at R&I level, in line with the integrated and long-term shared strategy of the European Universities and in synergy with their education dimension

- 3. increased **internationalization** of university activities in the field of R&I within and beyond Europe and raising the international profile
- 4. European Universities as a source of inspiration for successful cooperation and governance alignment models in the knowledge society (spreading and scaling up of solutions, successful practices and cooperation models)

- easier to access shared research infrastructures
