





*For our work we really need help. We don't have the expertise. We like to have students for this kind of job. They are very motivated and also have a little bit more time than full day working people.*





*Thanks to the students, we have the opportunity to learn more about the housing policies in other countries, taking inspiration to improve and develop the housing services we are carrying out locally.*
