- No hidden areas

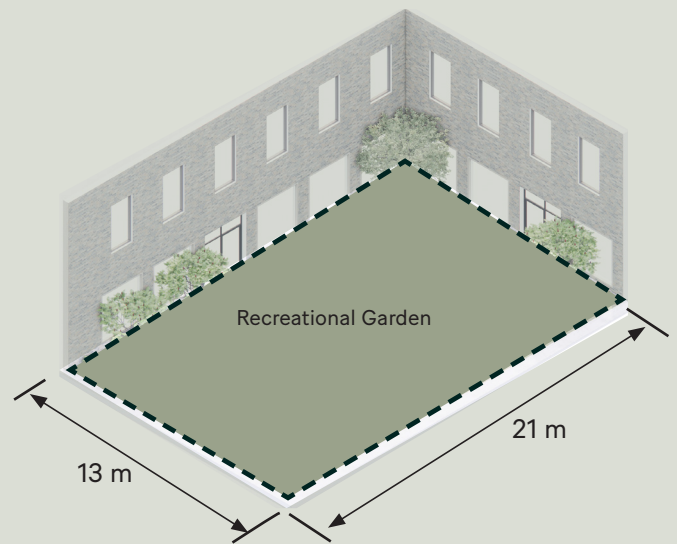
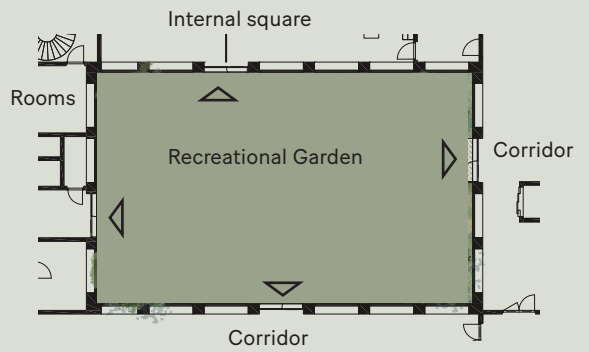
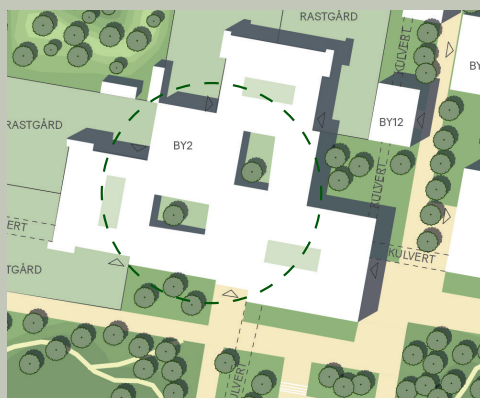
