#### **Our mission**

The BA in Ancient Archaeology aims at preparing professional staff and at contributing to the scientific improvement in the fields of archaeology and heritage, especially focusing on pre-Islamic past at national and international level.

#### **Degree structure**

The new BA in Ancient Archaeology of the University of Kufa is a 4 years program including 33 teaching units focusing on the most updated archaeological concepts, issues and analytical techniques.

The 1st year provides a solid introduction in archaeological concepts and practical activities.

During the 2<sup>nd</sup> year, students will be provided with a more advanced understanding of several topics including pre-Islamic material culture, remote sensing and GIS and technical drawing.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> years will be dedicated to the analysis of Ancient Mesopotamian architecture, Museum and Heritage studies.
