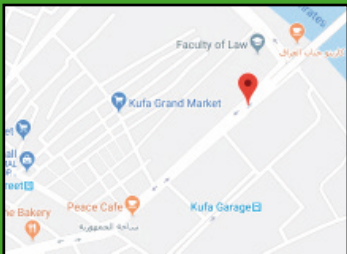

## Our mission

The BA in Ancient Archaeology aims at preparing professional staff and at contributing to the scientific improvement in the fields of archaeology and heritage, especially focusing on pre-Islamic past at national and international level.

## Degree structure

The new BA in Ancient Archaeology of the University of Kufa is a **4 years program** including **33 teaching units** focusing on the most updated archaeological concepts, issues and analytical techniques.

The **1<sup>st</sup> year** provides a solid introduction in archaeological concepts and practical activities.

During the **2<sup>nd</sup> year**, students will be provided with a more advanced understanding of several topics including pre-Islamic material culture, remote sensing and GIS and technical drawing.

The **3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> years** will be dedicated to the analysis of Ancient Mesopotamian architecture, Museum and Heritage studies.

## Our facilities

The faculty is provided with **study rooms**, a **library with multi-language scientific books** and **laboratories** including the most updated tools for conservation, topography, fieldwork and the study of material culture.

## Our staff

Our staff members include **lecturers and professors** specialized in different fields and with national and international cooperation experience.

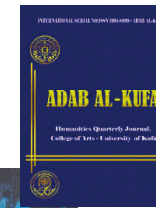
## Fieldwork and internships

The new course will also include two types of practical activities:

**Fieldwork.** Excavations and surveys carried out in collaboration with international institutions, will be useful to put in practice the students' theoretical skills developed during the course.

**Internships.** Students will have the opportunity to attend a one month internship program in it local Shrines of Najaf as well as the SBAH seats to learn the job.
