Our mission

The BA in Cuneiform Studies aims at preparing professional staff and at contributing to the scientific improvement in the fields of philology and archaeology, especially focusing on pre-Islamic language of ancient Mesopotamia.

Degree structure

The new BA in Cuneiform Studies of the University of Qadisiyah is a **4 years program** including **33 teaching units** focusing on the most updated archaeological concepts, philological abilities and analytical techniques.

The **1**st **and 2**nd **years** provide a solid introduction in archaeological and linguistic concepts and practical activities.

During the **3**rd **year**, students will be provided with a more advanced understanding of several topics including Akkadian and Sumerian grammar and the ancient history of Iraq.

The **4**th **year** will be dedicated to the translation of cuneiform texts and the study of excavation methodology.

Our facilities

The faculty is provided with study rooms, a library with multi-language scientific books and laboratories including the most updated tools for conservation, topography, fieldwork and the study of material culture.

Fieldwork and internships

The new course will include two types of practical activities:
