

Our mission

The BA in Islamic Archaeology aims at preparing professional staff and at contributing to the scientific improvement in the fields of archaaeology and heritage, especially focusing on the Islamic past at national and international level.

Degree structure

The new BA in Islamic Archaeology of the University of Qadisiyah is a **4 years program** including **33 teaching units** focusing on the most updated archaeological concepts, issues and analytical techniques.

The **1**st **year** provides a solid introduction in archaeological concepts and practical activities.

During the **2**nd **year**, students will be provided with a more advanced understanding of several topics including Islamic material culture, remote sensing and GIS and technical drawing.

The **3**rd **and 4**th **years** will be dedicated to the analysis of Islamic architecture from the Middle East, Museum and Heritage studies.

Our facilities

The faculty is provided with study rooms, a library with multi-language scientific books and laboratories including the most updated tools for conservation, topography, fieldwork and the study of the material culture.

Our staff

Our staff members include **lecturers and professors** specialized in different fields and with national and international cooperation experience.

Fieldwork and internships

The new course will include two types of practical activities:

Fieldwork. Excavations and surveys carried out in collaboration with international institutions, will be useful to put in practice the students' theoretical skills developed during the course.

Internships. Students will have the opportunity to attend a one month internship program in the SBAH to learn the job.
