Teaching Programme (22.10.-23.12)

- Participants have chosen a research topic (thesis, publication, current research work)
- AIMS:
 - Writing an article in English
 - Presenting the topic to a wider audience in English
- Teaching programme: one-to-one mentoring, selected lectures and courses to support the individual research and working in the libraries



Individual supervision:

- discussing methodological and theoretical approaches
- formulating of key issues
- reporting on current state of the research
- preparing the article and the presentation



Individual courses:

- Introduction into methods and tools for the work in the field, archaeological documentation with examples from various projects/excavations
- Introductory and advanced seminar on GIS
- Digital drawing seminar



Courses from the current studying programme:

- Introduction into the Ancient Near Eastern Archaeology (seminar)
- „Digitized data vs. Printed catalogue“ & „Ancient Near East in Wikipedia“ (seminars)
- Introduction into geophysical survey (lecture)
- „Cuneiform workshop“ (advanced seminar on cuneiform texts)
- Language courses: Sumerian, Akkadian (introductory and advanced)
- Intensive workshops (together with Senior Staff)

- Feedback and discussion of studying structure



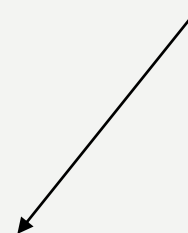
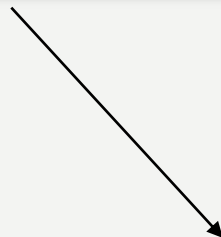
