### **1. Monitoring activities carried out at the host university**

The working group carried out monitoring activities on the new teaching units and the new laboratories at the University of Baghdad in November 2019.

2. Introduction to GIS (Claudia D'Orazio, phd student, 10-16 November 2019).
3. Introduction to Sumerian Language (Gabriele Giacosa, phd student, 10-16 November 2019).
4. Methods in the Archaeological Research (Elena Maini, research fellow/staff member, 2-12 November 2019).
5. The Archaeology and History of Egypt in the New Kingdom (Elena Maini, research fellow/staff member, 2-16 November 2019).

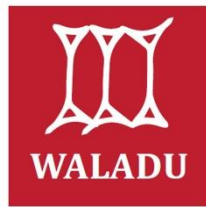
Two group members monitored the use of WaLab during the monitoring period:

Several academic books have been used by the professor teaching in all the five teaching units. In particular, WaLab was extensively used for Ancient Mesopotamian Languages, Introduction to Sumerian Language and The Archaeology and History of Egypt in the New Kingdom.

The technical materials kept in the WaLab, were used by the professor teaching in all the five teaching units. In particular, the laptops and software have been extensively used for Introduction to GIS and Methods in the Archaeological Research.

## **2. Outcomes and impact**

During the monitoring activities we had the opportunity to discuss with both the professors and the students. Professors confirmed that, thanks to the support of the new teaching materials and the labs, they could better introduce the students the theoretical concepts of the topics and also provide them with practical sessions.

On their side, students, while underlining the initial difficulty to deal with books in and software in English they acknowledge their usefulness. They also recognized a substantial improvement in the overall teaching quality compared to the previous years.

## **3. Final recommendations**

The overall quality of the teaching units satisfies the standards. However there are few minor recommendation the working group would like to point out in order to further improve the teaching quality:

1. Professors should improve the involvement of students in the discussion of the daily topic, by asking them question or giving them short essays or reading weeks to prepare and to explain to the class.
2. Professor should follow further English courses during the academic year in order to be able also to provide some lectures in English.
3. Students should be more encouraged and stimulated to use both WaLib and WaLab outside the lesson hours (always with the supervision of the librarian and the technical staff).
